

What happened?

Nazi laws in Germany meant that Jewish people:


- Couldn't go to school
- Couldn't marry people who weren't Jewish
- · Weren't allowed to vote
- Weren't allowed to do many jobs

For example, when Otto Deutsch was 10 years old, there were new laws in Austria where he lived:

'A Jew mustn't own a bicycle, nor a pet. I went to the local park and saw a sign saying Jews forbidden – I wasn't allowed to kick my football about in the park.'







What happened?

The Nazis killed 6 million Jewish people during the Holocaust.

Anne Frank lived in hiding when the Nazis tried to take her family away. They hid for two years before being found.






Bernd Koschland came to England as a child to escape the Nazis. He had to leave his family behind.

Susan Pollack survived horrible treatment by the Nazis. Lots of her family were killed.







What can we do?


Households across the UK light candles and safely put them in their windows to:

- stand against prejudice and hatred today


